EISA Is coming, are you prepared?

Speaker: Joseph Howley Jr. – Manager, Industry Relations and Environmental Marketing – GE Consumer & Industrial Lighting

EISA (Energy Independence and Security Act 2007) is geared to reduce energy consumption, decrease our dependency on oil, and addresses global climate change. A portion of the bill mandates the regulation of metal halide ballast efficiencies, on or after January 1, 2009, and is going to change the way we think about metal halide in the lighting community.

What does EISA mean to the future of incandescent and metal halide lamp technologies? What does this mean for fixtures already installed, and what does it mean for the specifications that you have written and will write in the future? The effects of this legislation will be far reaching. Our speaker, Joseph Howley, will give us the details of EISA and answer any questions you may have.

Mr. Howley is Manager of Industry Relations and Environmental Marketing for GE's lighting business. He has 25 years of experience with GE and has worked in several different technical marketing positions. Mr. Howley has an Architectural Engineering Degree from Penn State University and an MBA from Lake Erie College. He is the incoming Chairman of the Lighting Division of the National Electrical Manufacturers Association (NEMA) and Chairman of Electro-Federation's Lamp Committee in Canada. In addition, Mr. Howley is the past Chairman of the ASHRAE/IESNA 90.1 National Building Energy Code Lighting Subcommittee. Within IESNA, he is a member of the Energy Management Committee, the Membership Committee and the Legislative and Regulatory Affairs Committee.
